



OVERVIEW	<p>In English we offer an inclusive curriculum that provides the opportunity to encounter a wide range of texts written by diverse voices. It aims to engage and inspire students to develop a love of literature and master the written and oral skills required for life.</p> <p>In Year 11 students continue their GCSE courses. In English Language they revise how to produce fictional and transactional writing and analyse writers' use of language and structure to both entertain and persuade the reader. In Literature they learn how to analyse a text and understand writers' ideas about the human condition.</p>

They will also learn how to make inferences about a text and compare different writer's perspectives.
