<b>Curriculum Intent</b>	The RS curriculum at Salford City Academy will educate our community about the world's major religions, leading to understanding, tolerance and acceptance of all communities and cultures in modern Britain.
<b>KS3 Curriculum</b>	The curriculum builds on students' cumulative understanding of the major world religions, human rights and issues of morality. The curriculum is strategically planned to ensure that pupils gain a solid foundation knowledge of the three main world religions in Year 7 (taught in chronological order). In Year 8 the curriculum increases in complexity as students apply prior knowledge to learn more about traditions, beliefs and festivals celebrated within the main religions. In Year 9 students begin to explore the current moral and ethical dilemmas within the world and the impact of religion upon them.
