JOE WILSON

WHEN A BRILLIANT IDEA FOR A CHILDREN'S NOVEL HIT HIM ONE DAY AT THE BEACH, BBC SPORTS JOURNALIST JOE WILSON COULDN'T LET IT GO – EVEN THOUGH THE RESULTING BOOK TOOK 15 YEARS TO WRITE.

MR MCGIVERON BOOK RECOMMENDATION

FAVOURITE BOOK – THE RAGGED TROUSERED PHILANTHROPISTS BY ROBERT TRESSELL

SET IN THE EARLY 1900'S AROUND A GROUP OF WORKING MEN. IT COMPLETELY RIPS APART THE CAPITALIST NATURE OF SOCIETY BY ATTACKING THE GREED AND DISHONESTY AT ITS CORE.
