

Layer different liquids in a tube and discover how and why they settle in a certain order. The method

- Start by adding food colouring to the surgical spirit and to the water usin a different shade for each. This will allow you to identify each liquid. Measure out equal quantities of each liquid.
   Add them to the tube, one by one.

Try weighing each liquid before you add it and predict which order the liquids will settle in. The loyers may be a little mixed at first. Allow them to settle for a moment and watch the loyers start to define.
