This development of specialist learning spaces, creating new performing arts, ICT and music rooms, will allow the school to participate in a wide range of performing arts activities.



The dining expansion facility will see the existing dining space increased in size allowing more indoor seating, and an upgraded kitchen, to ensure the highest quality of food and service for the students. The bright, contemporary dining area will have the feeling of a café environment with full height windows, with a mixture of podium and booth seating, along with traditional table seating.

Vivid graphics on the wall will reflect the school's key values along with highlighting the need to focus on wellbeing, health, and the environment. In addition, this area will also have an option for outdoor dining with another bespoke canopy which links into the dining extension.
