Subject: Combined Science

Year 11

Students follow the AQA GCSE Combined Science course and continue to build on the knowledge and understanding gained from Year 10. Lessons include regular retrieval practice and past paper questions across current and past topics to build up recall and application skills in readiness for their exams. Students continue to study topics across biology, chemistry and physics with a mixture of theory and practical work. Students are taught by two teachers, each taking 4 lessons a fortnight.
