



OVERVIEW

In Year 11 students complete their GCSE course. They will prepare for and sit 4 exams for Spanish: Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing. Each of these exams is worth 25% of their final grade. Students begin the year with the school and future plans topic which is a familiar topic from KS3. They will then move onto the environmental and social issues topics which are relatively unfamiliar. The healthy living topic revisits food and drink language as well as sports and free time language from Year 10. Students finish the year by revisiting the holiday topic, which is an excellent way to revisit languages and the three time frames before their final exams.
