

As students begin to study the first topic of **Christianity** within their first GCSE term, they will gain the knowledge and understanding of both Christian beliefs and practices. Students will be guided to retrieve knowledge acquired from KS3 and use this knowledge as a solid foundation to build on; to aid the learning of higher-level detail and content. After studying the first faith study of two, Y10 students will then begin to study the first of four ethical themes. Theme A, relationships and families presents religious and ethical perspectives towards a range of different issues we face within our lives such as sex before marriage. Students will be required to apply their knowledge gained from studying the Christian beliefs module earlier in the year, to identify Christian attitudes on such topics. In the final term of Y10, students will complete 50% of the course and study the second of four modules, matters of life and death. This is where students will learn about a range of divergent Christian and non- religious views towards the creation of the universe and humans, as well as contemporary issues such as abortion and euthanasia. The module on **Muslim** beliefs will continue to Y11.
