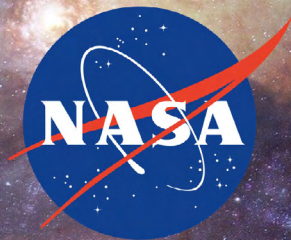


Eccles Sixth Form College had a visit from Juan Mata, who delivered a practical skills workshop and spoke about his experience as a professional football player.

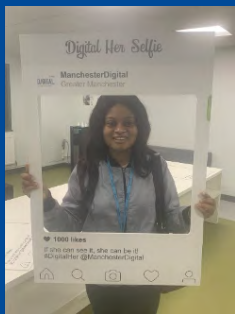
WORK EXPERIENCE

STUDENT STORIES

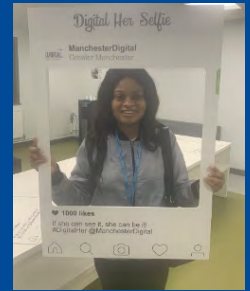

Rebecca studied IT, Computing & Games at FutureSkills at MediaCityUK.

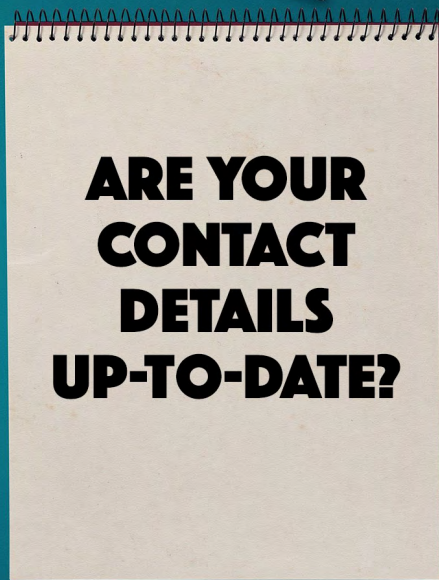
